






BEE NATIONAL LEVEL PAINTING COMPETITION-2021

State Level Competition

Procedures to be followed by the participants:

 Individual students should register themselves through web-portal link http://www.bee-studentsaward.in/register



- In view of ongoing COVID Pandemic, permission/acceptance from parents/guardian/school Principal to participate in State Level Painting competition.
- State Level Painting Competition shall be conducted on 5th December 2021, Sunday (10.30 AM) on all Educational Districts. (On 01-12-2021, competition center details will be shared to registered participants through EMC website: www.keralaenergy.gov.in)
- Group A and Group B participating students may select any one of the following approved topics to draw a painting;
 - > Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav: Energy Efficient India
 - Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav: Cleaner Planet
- A3 sheets, drawing sheets of 300 GSM of pale-yellow colour required for the competition will be provided to the students by the organizers.
- Participants should bring painting materials such as: Pencil, Pencil Color, Crayons, Water colors, drawing boards, etc. required for the competition.
- Use of Collage/Patchwork is not permitted at any level of competition.
- Students should fill the back of Drawing Sheet with the following details in the designated areas as below.
