Kindly confirm the area to be covered for surveying/ project.</p> | <p>The area to be covered is to be decided by the consultant to optimally design the project based on the locality. Discussions can be made with EMC during the work. In case the total area to be surveyed is more than specified (mentioned based on the initial understanding of the locality) the cost for additional area may be provided at Rs. 5000/- per acre.</p> |
| 8 | <p>The tender documents reveal that all the tendered projects except Kuliramutty & Kakkadampoil II have old DPRs whereas Kuliramutty & Kakkdampoil have only data like flow etc. Kindly confirm.</p> | <p>Yes, Kakkadampoil –II has a DIR available.</p> |
| 9 | <p>Tender document clause on Performance Guarantee, 18.1: We presume that the performance guarantee amount is 5% of the proposed value of the contract which is as per industry standard. Kindly confirm since there is a typographical error between the figure in words and figure in digits.</p> | <p>Typographical error is acknowledged. Performance guarantee shall be 5% of the contract value</p> |
| 10 | <p>Tender document clause '6' states that advance payments will be released for respective projects against Bank Guarantee as per terms. Kindly inform the terms for availing the same.</p> | <p>Draft for BG will be shared with the successful bidder. The BG will be of standard form for advances as per government projects</p> |
