State, CEIC to ink MoU

The Kerala government will ink a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Clean Energy International Incubation Centre (CEIC) on Tuesday for establishing a Clean Energy Incubation Centre in the State.

The centre is meant to promote green energy start-ups and help establish a robust foundation for the sector in Kerala. The centre will be established jointly by agencies under the State Power department, the Kerala Development and Innovation Strategic Council (K-DISC) and CEIC.

The CEIC will provide the necessary technical expertise for the venture. The Energy Management Centre, Kerala, (EMC), will represent Power department agencies including the Kerala State Electricity Board, Electrical Inspectorate and the Agency for Non-conventional Energy and Rural Technology (Anert). The EMC, K-DISC and CEIC will sign the agreement in the presence of Electricity Minister K. Krishnankutty.
