MoU signed for clean energy tech

Thiruvananthapuram: The state government, through the Energy Management Centre (EMC) and Kerala Development and Innovation Strategy Council (KDISC), has entered into a memorandum of understanding with Social Alpha through its Clean Energy International Incubation Centre (CEIC).

The MoU underlines the joint commitment of EMC, KDISC and CEIC to work together in the areas of innovative, clean energy technologies which integrate with the initiatives and programmes of the state government. This collaboration will also facilitate the state in curating inno-

vative technologies for deployment through government initiatives for addressing the challenges in the power sector and energy access for all. The jointly set-up incubation centre will leverage the labs and infrastructure.
